The regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville was held on October 13, 2004 at 7:30 p.m. at Pioneer Hall. All members were present and there were 28 guests. Mr. Cardamone opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance.

After audit, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to pay bill 16 on Trust and Agency abstract #10 for \$10,854.15.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Lewis, to pay bills 103-115 on Water abstract #10 for \$4381.67.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to pay bills 196-219 on Highway abstract #10 for \$67,304.34.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to pay bills 447-496 on General abstract #10 for \$16,7770.03.

The water report was reviewed. Mr. Bear reported that the school is in the process of being hooked up to the district.

Mr. Bear reported that a heating system is being installed in the north barn and a goal post is being repaired.

After discussion with the Highway Supt. Hempstead, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to purchase a stainless steel sander from Tarant for \$3613 on state contract.

County Planning Director, Warren Hart will be asked to attend a zoning workshop in the near future.

The Town Board heard from residents about an event that occurred on E Red Mill Road on Sept 11th and 12th. Pat Leonard, Blair Allen, Roy Gunderson and Gail Biskipich complained of undue noise and unhealthy dust levels. The owner of the property, Cyril Kearney, denied any fees were charged and indicated his desire to hold similar events in the future.

The Town Board will conduct a workshop on the 2005 budget on Oct. 20 at 7:30 p.m..

The Board acknowledged a request from Richard Ferriolo to display the Veteran's Book of Honor in the meeting room and indicated it would be done.
