The regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville was held on April 14, 2004 at 7:30pm at the Pioneer hall. All Board members were present and there were 45 guests, including attorney Ted Hilscher. Mr. Cardamone opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance.

After reading by the Clerk, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to accept the minutes of March 10, 2004.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to pay bills 8-10 on Trust and Agency abstract #4 for \$13,491.87.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Cardamone, to pay bill 3 on Water Capital abstract #2 for \$15,253.33.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to pay bills 41-51 on Water abstract #4 for \$6975.40.

After audit, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to pay bills 67-95 on Highway abstract #4 for \$64,270.07.

Bob Augustene, Cignal Tower, presented information for a potential cell tower at the Highway property including potential coverage area and pole types.

A letter has been received from the Cultural Arts Center Advisory Council requesting use of the grounds for a yard sale.

After discussion with Jim Hauck, Chamber of Commerce, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to permit the Chamber to use the park facilities for the annual balloon festival with no cost to the Town and the guarantee to return the site to its original condition after the event.
