

## June 9, 2004

The regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville was held on June 9, 2004 at 7:30pm at the Pioneer hall. All Board members were present and there were 50 guests, including attorney, Ted Hilscher.

Mr. Cardamone opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance. Mr. Nugent asked that a moment of silence be observed to honor the passing of former President Reagan.

After reading by the Clerk, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to accept the minutes of May 12 and May 19.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to pay bills 12-13 on Trust and Agency abstract #6 for \$42,559.87.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to pay bill 9 on Pioneer abstract #5 for \$192.43.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Kraker moved, seconded by Mr. Lewis, to pay bills 59-69 on Water abstract #6 for \$3282.02.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to pay bills 119-138 on Highway abstract #6 for \$25,629.85.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Kraker moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to pay bills 252-281 and 283-298 on General abstract #6 for \$23,521.78.

Carried 5 ayes

After review, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Cardamone, to accept the water report for May. Discussion on the next phase of the capital water project.

Carried 5 ayes

Estimates are being obtained for the resurfacing of the basketball courts in the Park.

After discussion, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to permit the Greenville Chamber of Commerce to apply for a three day beer license covering the Balloon Festival and to authorize the Supervisor to sign as landlord.

Carried 5 ayes

Venders will be permitted to set up their rvs for use during the festival.

Highway Sup't Hempstead announced that a full time highway position is available.

After discussion, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to advertise for an part time assistant Code Enforcement Officer.

Carried 5 ayes

An informational meeting concerning issues of interest to the residents of Norton Hill will be held on July 7 at 7:00pm at the Methodist meeting hall.

Virginia Mangold, Greenville Cultural Arts Center, submitted a list of needed improvements to the building. Discussion on various items and funding.

After discussion, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to permit musical group Ridgerunners to use the gazebo to provide seasonal entertainment on Mondays

Carried 5 ayes

Blair Allen submitted a letter and asked the Board to address the storage building built on East Red Mill Road. Mr. Hilscher replied that an investigation has been done and no apparent violation exists at this time.

Ronald Roth, BAR member, submitted a letter detailing events which occurred on Grievance Day, June 2.

Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to accept the Supervisor's report for May.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Cardamone introduced a resolution authorizing audio/video recording of Town Board meetings. The audience was asked to comment. During discussion, Jamie Albin offered to donate audio equipment which would provide better sound quality during the meetings and provide for tape recording. No second was received to the motion.

Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to remove the present video and audio equipment and to permit amplification and audio recording equipment donated by Jamie Albin to be installed at the council table. All Board members will be amplified by individual microphones and one microphone will be provided for the public.

Mr. Kraker moved, seconded by Mr. Cardamone, to accept the attached resolution transferring funds in the General, Highway and Water accounts.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to accept the attached resolution adopting procedures for compliance with Justice Department hiring requirements.

Carried 5 ayes

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Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to place the proceeds of the sale of the

Imagex Building into the Pioneer Building Capital Project account.  
Carried 5 ayes

After discussion, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to accept the attached resolution requesting NYS DOT to investigate speed limits on O'Hara Road, Red Mill Road, East Red Mill Road, Big Woods Road, Alberta Lane and County Route 67.  
Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to enter executive session to discuss pending litigation.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to return to regular session.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to appoint Eliot Dalton to the Zoning Board of Appeals to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Len DiGiovine for a term ending 2007.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Cardamone moved to reappoint Jim Goode to the vacant ZBA position. There was no second.

Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to appoint Tom Briggs to fill the vacant ZBA position for a term ending 2008.

Carried 4 ayes Mr Cardamone nay

There being no further business, Mr. Nugent moved to adjourn at 11:25.
