

**March 21, 2005**

A special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville was held on March 21, 2005 at 7:00 pm at Pioneer Hall to consider a local law regulating the sewer district.. All Board members were present and there were 21 guests, including attorney Ted Hilscher.

Mr. Cardamone opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance.

Charles Schembri asked the Board for additional time to review the proposed law and to set up a committee to make recommendation.

Mr. Hilscher advised that rules and regulations should be in place before more than one or two houses come on line.

Alan Tavener, Delaware Engineering, outlined the importance of proper testing and verification on installations especially in paved areas.

Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to form a committee to review the sewer law with Councilman Nugent as Chair, and members Councilman Lewis, Charles or Peter Schembri, Bob Bolte and Ruth Jones. Mr. Hilscher and Mr. Tavener will review all recommendations.

Mr. Lewis led a discussion on potential funding of the district.

Mr Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to enter executive session to discuss the personal history of a particular person.

Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to return to regular session.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Kraker moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to direct the Supervisor to make a salary offer to an employee.

There being no further business, Mr. Cardamone moved to adjourn at 8:51 pm.
