

## August 10, 2005

The regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville was held on August 10, 2005 at 7:30 pm at Pioneer Hall. Councilman Lewis was absent and there were 38 guests including attorney Andy Brick. Mr. Cardamone opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance.

On the request of Mr. Brick, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to enter executive session for attorney client privilege.

Carried 4 ayes 1 absent

Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Cardamone, to return to regular session.

Carried 4 ayes 1 absent

On the recommendation of Mr. Brick, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker to cancel the public hearing on a local law regulating motor vehicle racing, and to incorporate regulations into the future comprehensive plan.

Carried 3 ayes Mr. Cardamone opposed 1 absent

After reading by the Clerk, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to accept the minutes of July 13.

Carried 4 ayes 1 absent

Leroy Bear reported on preparations for the balloon festival at the Park.

The water report for July was reviewed. Several complaints of sulfur have been received and are being addressed. On the recommendation of Mr. Bear, Mr. Cardamone moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to bill Schembri Homes for the landscape watering.

Carried 4 ayes 1 absent

Mr. Brick discussed the procedure for setting speed limits on Town roads. He will research and report back to the Board.

After a request by Wayne Nelson, Freehold Beautification project, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent to submit a letter requesting a cross walk on Route 67.

Carried 4 ayes 1 absent

Mr. Brick reported on the sewer use law. Mr. Nugent will set up a meeting to finalize.

After discussion, Mr. Kraker moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to repair instead of replace the Pioneer roof. More information will be obtained before proceeding. No vote taken.

Mr. Lewis arrived at 8:15 pm.

CEO Bill Silk reported on code enforcement activities.

Eleanor Werking, All Arts Matters, reported on repairs needed to the Cultural Arts Center. The Board will investigate and prioritize.

Gloria Bear reported on the summer youth program. There were 140 participants this year. She recommends that the non resident fee be increased to \$50 with a possible reduced family plan. Ms. Bear was highly commended for a successful program.

After discussion, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to increase the milage reimbursement for town employees to the federal limit.

Carried 5 ayes

Responses are being gathered to the comprehensive planning committee letters.

Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to conduct a public hearing on the proposed contract with the Freehold Fire Company at 7:30 pm on Sept. 14.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to enter executive session for attorney client privilege.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to return to regular session.

Carried 5 ayes

During the open to the public session, Alan Friedman spoke on including a teen representative to the comprehensive planning committee and Robert Johnson asked the Board to consider background checks on town employees and volunteers.

After review, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent to accept the Supervisor's report for July.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Cardamone, to pay bill 13 on Trust and Agency abstract #8 for \$2938.60.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to pay bills 55-61 on Sewer abstract #7 for \$4103.65.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Cardamone moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to pay bills 98-111 on Water abstract #8 for \$20,479.16

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Kraker moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to pay bills 198-215 on Highway abstract #8 for \$11,117.36.

Carried 5 ayes

After audit, Mr. Seeley moved, seconded by Mr. Cardamone, to pay bills 355-393 on General abstract #8 for \$14,508.25
