

September 14, 2005

The regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville was held on September 14, 2005 at 7:30 pm at Pioneer Hall. Councilmen Kraker and Seeley were absent and there were 42 guests. Mr. Cardamone opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance.

The public hearing for the contract with Freehold Fire Company was held. No public comment was received. Mr. Cardamone moved, seconded by Mr. Lewis, to close the public hearing and enter regular session.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent to authorize the Supervisor to sign the contract with Freehold Fire Company to provide fire protection for Freehold for three years at \$80,000 per year.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

After reading by the Clerk, Mr. Kraker moved, seconded by Mr. Cardamone, to accept the minutes of August 10.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

George Hood, Boy Scout Troop 42, introduced eagle scout candidate Joseph Belarge who described his proposed community project for Board approval. He also discussed the need to amend the contract for use of the Boy Scout Building. Both items were tabled due to lack of sufficient quorum as Councilman Lewis is a member of the troop.

James Goode was recognized to express his view that the executive session was incorrectly used at the August 10 meeting. Mr. Cardamone read a statement detailing his participation in the meeting. Terrence Ruebush submitted a letter on the subject. - attached. Andrew Brick explained the use of executive session and attorney client privilege. After an extensive discussion on the cancelled public hearing on regulating motor vehicle racing, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to hold a work session to formulate a local law regulating motor vehicle racing on Sept 21 at 7:00 pm.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

Leroy Bear reported that the trails in the park have been trimmed.

The water report for August was reviewed.

Highway Superintendent Hempstead reported that Mountain View Road resurfacing has been completed. The proposed logo for town vehicles was shown.

Mr. Nugent reported that the sewer law was ready for consideration. Mr. Cardamone moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to hold a public hearing on a local law regulating the sewer district on Oct 12 at 7:30 pm.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

Several residents related problems with building violations. Mr. Silk will be asked to investigate.

Mr. Cardamone reported that he has completed review of the proposed employee manual. It will be sent to Amtek for updating.

Mr. Bear reported on a possible security system for the Town Hall. The purchase was tabled due to lack of quorum as Mr. Cardamone has had dealings with the vender.

Mr. Brick reported that his research indicates that the Town must ask NYS DOT to set speed limits on Town roads. Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Lewis, to request DOT to conduct a survey of O'Hara and Mountain View Roads.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

After audit, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to pay bill 14 on Trust and Agency abstract #9 for \$6513.17.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

After audit, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Lewis, to pay bills 62-68 on Sewer abstract #8 for \$4886.88.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

After audit, Mr. Cardamone moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to pay bills 112-122 on Water abstract #9 for \$2,555.01

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

After audit, Mr. Cardamone moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to pay bills 216-241 on Highway abstract #9 for \$60,608.51.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

After audit, Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Cardamone, to pay bills 394-436 on General abstract #9 for \$52,420.11.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

After review, Mr. Nugent moved, seconded by Mr. Lewis, to accept the Supervisor's report for August.

Carried 3 ayes 2 absent

There being no further business, Mr. Cardamone moved to adjourn at 10:15 pm.
