

September 21, 2005

A special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Greenville was held on September 21, 2005 at 7:00 pm at Pioneer Hall in order to conduct a workshop on regulating use of land and buildings for motor vehicle racing. All Board members were present and there were 48 guests including attorney Andrew Brick.

Tabled items were acted upon as follows.

Mr. Cardamone moved, seconded by Mr. Nugent, to approve and authorize the Supervisor to sign to new contract with Boy Scout Troop 42 on use of the Boy Scout Building.

Carried 4 ayes Mr. Lewis abstained as troop member

Mr. Cardamone moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to approve the eagle scout project of Joseph Belarge. Carried 4 ayes Mr. Lewis abstained as troop member

Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to expend \$2782 to Scott Alarm to provide fire and security alarm system for the Pioneer building.

Carried 4 ayes Mr. Cardamone abstained as he has had dealings with the vendor

A workshop was held on developing a law regulating motor vehicle racing. Mr. Brick stated that he advised the Board to withdraw the original proposal as it was not what the majority of the members were in favor of. He related options to the proposal that would make it less restrictive to individuals and more directed to commercial operations. Mr. Cardamone stated his favorable view of the original proposal. Mr. Nugent would like individual use of snowmobile and ongoing events such as snowmobile racing or grass drags exempted. Mr. Seeley would like individuals exempted. Mr. Lewis would like a law regulating racing rather than prohibiting it. Members of the audience were invited to participate. Their suggestions included limiting the size of tracks, neighbor notification, exempting existing events and community groups, environmental control, noise regulations, using existing special use requirements, code enforcement, clarification of terms, property rights and police enforcement. Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Seeley, to direct attorney Brick to draft a new proposal for the Board's consideration.

Carried 5 ayes

Mr. Cardamone asked Deputy Supervisor Mulligan to chair the remainder of the meeting and he left the room. A discussion between Mr. Garden, Ms Denton, and CEO Silk resulted in an agreement by Mr. Garden to lime the offending area by the coming weekend as recommended by the Health Dept.

Mr. Lewis moved, seconded by Mr. Kraker, to adjourn at 9:10 pm.
